The Albrighton Foodbank is an initiative of all the churches in Albrighton, working together to provide emergency food supplies to anyone who may need them.

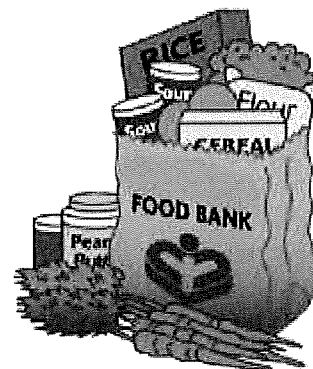
Staffed by volunteers and relying on donations of food and other items; we are open Friday mornings (9.30 – 10.30 am) and can offer support to clients who are referred to us with a food voucher.

We offer a weekly supply of food and other household items for up to three weeks for all who are referred to us.

Clients will need a food voucher which can be issued by referring agencies including housing officers and the GP surgery. Alternatively, please contact the Vicar [contact](#) or Curate [contact](#)

Clients can be assured of complete confidentiality and a warm, non-judgemental welcome. Our service is open to all, without exception, that who our referral agencies tell us are in need.

We will ask for certain information from each client on their first visit, to help us serve them better, but we will not share this with anyone else without their express permission.

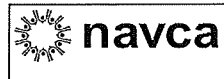

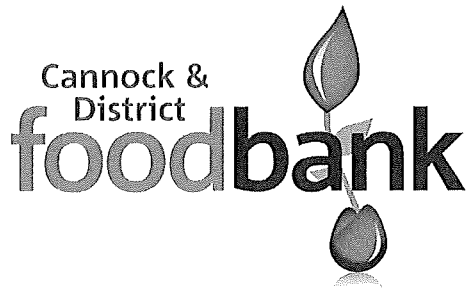

Re: COVID-19, operation of the Cannock and District foodbank

“The Cannock and District foodbank will continue to provide emergency food to people in crisis.”

If you live in the Cannock District and you need our help please call 01543 422394 between 9am-1pm Monday – Friday.

To families whose income has significantly been reduced at this time we have this message: we are here for you, we were setup exactly for such a time as this. With no judgment you can call our landline and we will stand with you and your family until your crisis is over by providing the food you need.

As of Monday 23rd March 2020, not all of our usual distribution centres will be open, if you already have one of our red foodbank vouchers please call 01543 422394 between 9am-1pm for advice on how to redeem it. Coniston Clothing is temporarily closed during this crisis. If you do need emergency clothing please contact the foodbank help line.

HOW TO HELP US

1. **Keep donating food** and other essentials: visit <https://cannockdistrict.foodbank.org.uk/give-help/donate-food/> for an up to date list of ‘shortages’. Items can either be dropped off at supermarket market collection points or taken to our central warehouse at Coniston Hall Cecil St, Cannock WS11 5DB.
2. **Donate money:** Every time we help a family with £40 worth of food, it costs us £5. Visit <https://cannockdistrict.foodbank.org.uk/give-help/donate-money/> to help us keep the lights on and staff paid at this time.
3. **Volunteer:** We have just slim lined our entire foodbank operation but over the coming weeks we may need a few more people to help with deliveries and helping man our warehouse.
